- China is to host the third edition of the Asian Youth Games (AYG) in Shantou in November 2021.
- The announcement was made by the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) on 1 April 2020.
- The third edition was supposed to be held in 2017. But was postponed to 2021 by OCA.

IOC sets new deadline for the qualification period of Tokyo Olympics

- The International Olympic Committee (IOC) announced that 29 June 2021 has been set as the new deadline for the qualification period of the Tokyo Olympics.
- The decision was made after discussion with the National Olympic Committee (NOC) Presidents, Secretary Generals and Chef de Missions, IOC Director of Solidarity and NOC relations.
- Tokyo Olympics was rescheduled to be held in 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The revised sport entries deadline has now been set for 5 July 2021.
- The committee also announced that the revision of the qualifications systems will be

finalized soon to give certainty to athletes and NOCs.

- The Independent Member Federation Sanctions Panel (IMFSP) of the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF) has banned the Malaysia & Thailand weightlifters from competing in Tokyo Olympics 2020.
- IMSP has imposed the disciplinary sanctions on both the countries from participating in weightlifting events at the Tokyo Olympics for doping violations.
- Due to the doping violations, the membership status of Thai Amateur Weightlifting Association (TAWA) has been suspended for a period of three years through to 1 April 2023 while Malaysian Weightlifting Federation (MWF) is suspended from all IWF activities for a period 12 months through to 1 April 2021.

India lost top spot in the ICC Test rankings to Australia

India lost the top spot in the ICC Test rankings to Australia on 1 May. It lost the rank because of the 2016-17 record was eliminated from the annual update as per rules.

Highlights:

- India dropped in the ladder largely because the record of 12 Tests victories and just one Test defeat in 201617 was removed in the latest chart.
- top-ranking Australia. the country, now has 116 points. It is followed by New Zealand with 115 points and India with 114 points.
- India yielded the top spot in Test rankings for the first time since October 2016. It continues to lead the ICC World Test Championship.

- The sample was deemed clean by the NDTL officials during the National Inter-State Championships in June 2018 in Guwahati.
- The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) then decided to test the sample of Kumari at its Montreal Laboratory in Canada.
- Her four-year ban, announced by WADA will begin from June 26, 2018 — the date of her sample collection.

Kumari's results from June 26, 2018 to November 21, 2018 will now be annulled.

Egypt tennis player Youssef Hossam banned for life on match-fixing charges

- Egyptian professional tennis player Youssef Hossam has been banned from professional tennis for life for match-fixing, as per the official notification by the Tennis Integrity Unit on 4 May 2020.

- India's Gomathi Marimuthu will be stripped off her 2019 Asian Athletics Championships gold medal after she was handed a four-year ban by the Athletics Integrity Unit for testing positive for a banned substance.
- The 'A' sample of the 30-year-old runner from Tamil Nadu, who clocked 2 minutes and 2.70 seconds to win the gold

medal on April 22 last year, had returned positive for a steroid in the test conducted during the Asian Championships in Doha.

• Now, Gomathi's 'B' sample has also tested positive and she will need to serve out a ban till May 16, 2023. In addition, she will also need to pay a fine of Rs 1 lakh to the AIU.

Asian Champion Runner Gomathi Marimuthu Banned For Four Years For Doping, Stripped of Asian Championships Gold

- Middle distance runner Gomathi Marimuthu, has been banned for four years and stripped off her 2019 Asian Championships gold medal by the Athletics Integrity Unity (AIU), until May 2023 for doping charges.
- The 31-year-old Marimuthu tested positive for anabolic steroid nandrolone at the 2019 Asian championships in April.
- The Tamil Nadu athlete has also been disqualified from all races between March 18 and May 17, 2019.
- Gomathi had clocked a personal best time of 2 minutes 02.70 seconds in the women's 800m race in Asian Athletics Championships 2019.
- It was the first time an Indian won gold in the women's 800m event in the competition.
